



# Rocket Badge

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## INTRODUCTION

Make a light-up Rocket Badge with our Maker Tape and wear it when you want to blast off to fun!





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## Step 1 — Cut it Out



- Print the top and bottom of the rocket on two different pieces of paper. (We recommend a heavier paper stock.)
- ⓘ We have a full-color version and a black & white version. Choose which one you want to use. (The black & white version is fun to color!)
- Cut out the top and bottom pieces, and use a hole punch to make holes in the tab for a string to so you can wear your badge.

## Step 2 — Build Your Circuit



- Using Maker Tape, a battery, and a red and blue LED build your circuit on the bottom part of the rocket.
- ⓘ See the template for instructions on bending the LED legs so they point the correct way.
- Add a piece of Maker Tape to act as a switch that can fold over the gap in the circuit to complete it.
- 👉 Use a paperclip as a "switch" to keep your circuit turned on while you wear it.

### Step 3 — Put it Together



- Bend the tabbed pieces on the top part of the rocket so they can go under/behind the bottom part of the rocket.
- ⓘ The "legs" of the top part of the rocket let it sit above the bottom part of the rocket so our LEDs have some room to glow.
- Attach the tab legs to the back/bottom of the rocket with tape or glue.

### Step 4 — Wear Your Badge



- Add some string to the holes on the top tabs.
- Enjoy your Rocket Badge!
