

INTRODUCTION

Flowers


This paper craft flower is a simple way to jazz up any fancy occasion. Follow the download the guide, watch the video, or follow the directions below.

TOOLS:

- Scissors (1)
- Clear Tape (1)


PARTS:Paper Circuits Kit (1)

Step 1 — Cut Out the Body




- Print off the template, trace it, and cut out your flower.
- If you plan on freehand cutting your body, be sure to read all the directions first. Pay special attention to how we create the battery holder.

Step 2 — Tape the Stem




- Use two lines of conductive tape, one on each side.
- Wrap one line of tape around the short leg of the stem.

Step 3 — Poke the LEDs Through




- Line up your layers of flower peddles and cut a slit in the middle of each one.
- Poke both LED legs through the slits.
- You want to leave enough room so that you can spread both legs apart a bit.

Step 4 — Connect them to the Tape




- Place one leg on each side of your stem, over the top of the tape. One leg per piece of tape.
- Cut off a small piece of tape and use it to tape down each of the LED legs to the conductive tape on the stem.

Step 5 — Add a Battery



- Place your battery at the bottom of the stem.
- Folder over the short end of the stem.
- Your LED should light up. If it does not, flip the battery over and see if that fixes things.

Step 6 — Secure Everything



- Use a paperclip or binder clip to hold the battery flap in place.
- Add in your leaves by using glue, tape, or other means.
- (i) Pin it to yourself to look cool at fancy dinner parties or events.
