- Hole Punch (1)


Step 1 — DIY Stencils

Step 2 — Trace Your Circles



- We've created a variety of stencils for you to get started making holes in paper (or felt) that will align with the studs on LEGO bricks.
- If you want the PDF file you can print just grab it from this guide.
 We recommend using heavy cardstock.


 For usage we recommend placing the stencil over your paper and drawing circles using a sharp pencil or a fine tip pen.

Step 3 — Punch Out Your Circles



 Once you have your circles drawn on the paper you can remove the stencil and use the hole punch to make the holes.

Step 4 — Add Some LEGO



• With the holes in place you can now attach the paper to LEGO bricks!

Step 5 — Check Out Some Examples!




• We built a few example projects to get the ideas flowing when you start to combine paper and LEGO!

Step 6 — Lightning Bug




• Build a Lightning Bug with some paper wings and add a Crazy Circuits LED to light it up!

Step 7 — Fireplace Shadowbox



• Create a Fireplace Shadowbox and add a red LED for some flame effects!

Step 8 — Blink/Fade Bracelet



• Use our Blink/Fade Board to create a bracelet with lighting effects!

Step 9 — Brick Bracelet



 Make a light-up "Brick Bracelet" using paper, Maker Tape, and some Crazy Circuit parts!

Step 10 — Holiday Trees




• Get ready for the Holidays with these light-up felt & LEGO trees!

Step 11 — 4 LED Light Up Bracelet



 Make a multi-colored 4 LED light up bracelet using a piece of felt along with some LEGO bricks and Crazy Circuit parts.
