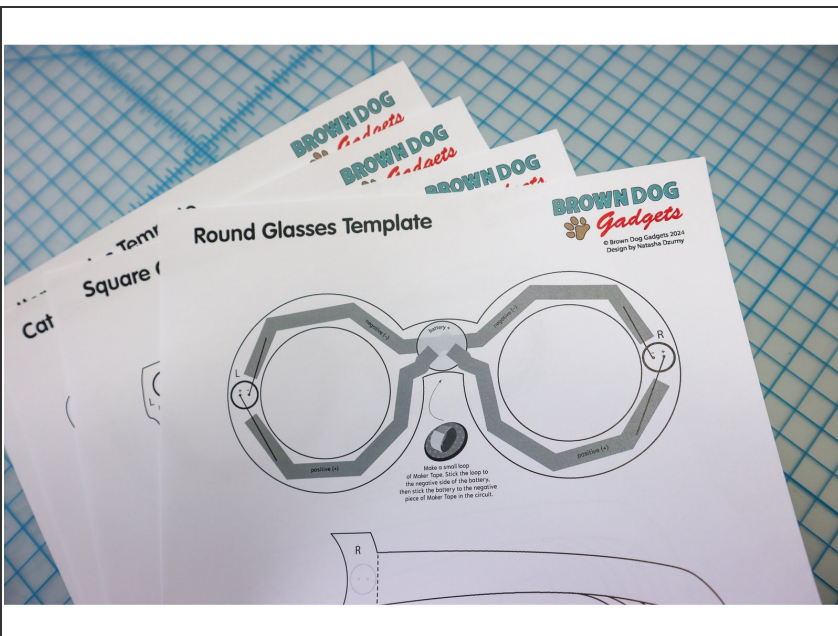

Step 1 — To the Recycling Bin!



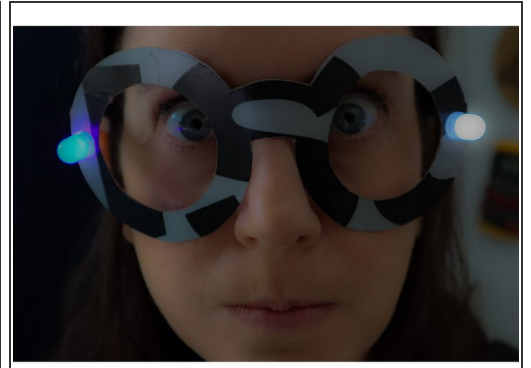
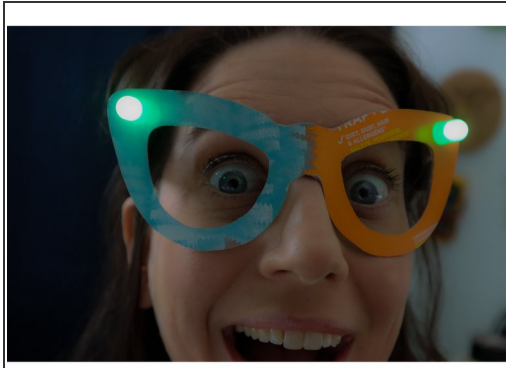
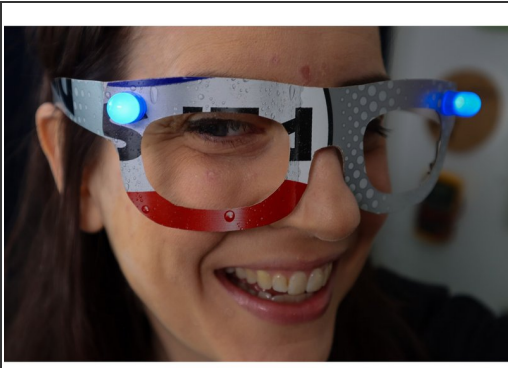
- Gather thin cardboard from the recycling bin. We've had luck with cereal boxes, soda boxes, and Swiffers!
